### **Proposed new footpath**

Progress has been made on the proposed path from The Antelope to Honeybun Meadow. The Chairman, clerk and NDDC Councillor met the Hall and Woodhouse surveyor who has agreed to draw up draft plans for us to discuss with the planners.

### **Sports Pavilion Plans**

The playing field committee have drawn up plans for a new pavilion to replace the two dilapidated buildings on Alec's field that can be used both for the sporting fixtures and events such as children's parties etc. They hope that with a new pavilion, football will be revived and the field will also be used for other sports.

### **Consultation on Traveller's sites**

The Parish Council have responded to the Consultation on Travellers sites in North Dorset based on the feedback gained at two public meetings and correspondence received.

The response and accompanying letter are published on the website and available from the clerk but in summary:

- a) We stated that we accept the 4 existing sites, both those included and excluded from the recommendations in the draft proposal. These can remain provided they do not increase in size.
- b) We do not accept the two new sites proposed at Military Lane, Kingston and Coney Lane, Pleck. We itemised the criteria defined in the consultation document for new sites which are not met by each site.
