 - The Chairman informed everyone that P.C. Sugrue has now been trained to use a mobile speed gun and is out and about in the parish.
 - Cllr Fox informed the Parish Council that the proposals for a speed reduction in Kings Stag will affect one road within our parish boundary.

- Cllr Fox informed the Parish Council that additional funding will be made available by Sturminster Newton Council for SIDS.
- Cllr Fox requested that the **Parish Clerk** furnish him with details of outstanding items for signs and finger posts.
