068/11	<p>Tribute to Ken Jackson</p> <p>The chairman read a tribute to Ken Jackson who had been Parish Clerk for 10 years and, thanks to his quiet hard work, leaves a legacy of much improved footpaths in the village.</p>	
069/11	<p>Written and Verbal Communicated Items</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ CAB – Following a request from the CAB for a donation, the Council agreed to donate £100. ▪ Royal Wedding Tea Party – The Council decided to decline a request for a contribution towards the tea party on the field on 29th April. It was agreed that the money should be reserved for the swimming pool restoration project. ▪ Speeding – The Council were informed that Marnhull has spent £1800 analysing traffic speed and it was agreed that there would be no benefit in doing a similar exercise in Hazelbury Bryan. ▪ Sign post to shops – A request has been received for a sign saying ‘Village Shops’ to be put on the finger post at the start of the Causeway. The costs will be established. ▪ Lydden Vale Councillor – Cllr Fox informed the meeting that he will not be standing for re-election for this post. He congratulated the Parish Council on what they had achieved during his time in the role. The Chairman thanked him for his support over the past years. ▪ Retiring Parish Councillors – The Chairman thanked Ann McCulloch, Emma Marshall and Barry Mayne for their contributions to the Parish Council.
