It was agreed to retain the precept at the same level as in 2011/12. The total is £14,580 which equates to £29.88 for a band D property. A suggestion from Cllr David Maughan to cut costs and reduce the precept by £2 – 28 PA per Band D household was rejected.

Cllr Steve Murcer expressed concern about the size of the reserve which will be monitored.
