024/13	<p><b>Road Safety Issues</b></p> <p><b>a) Snow Clearance</b></p> <p>It was <b>reported</b> that DCC will continue with the existing process for the rest of this financial year. It was <b>agreed</b> that Cllr Richards should make a proposal regarding the snow clearing required over and above that provided by DCC for the winter of 2013/14.</p>							
025/13	<p><b>b) Access track to The Keep</b></p> <p>It was <b>agreed</b> to take the advice from DCC highways and sweep /use a high pressure water hose to remove the algae from the track which they believe causes the slippery surface. The effectiveness will be reviewed.</p>	<b>RS</b>						
025/13	<p><b>c) Damaged Manhole covers on The Green</b></p> <p>It was <b>reported</b> that DCC highways will make safe the manhole covers in the grass that have been damaged by lorries driving over them to avoid parked cars.</p>							
026/13	<p><b>Recreation Association Report</b></p> <p>Further hedge-laying took place on 2<sup>nd</sup> February. Volunteers for the next one planned for late February / early March should contact Cllr Smith for details.(817206).</p>							
027/13	<p><b>The Village Hall Report</b></p> <p>Everyone is encouraged to attend activities in the village hall. The next one on 21<sup>st</sup> February is a half-term children’s puppet show by the Angel Pet group. Details of tickets are displayed outside the hall.</p>							
028/13	<p><b>Update from Cllr Pauline Batstone (NDDC)</b></p> <p>(i) The element of council tax levied by NDDC will be either £104.78 or £109.78 for a band D property depending if they decide to accept the Freeze Grant or take the additional £5 allowed by the De Minimus ruling. Savings of £400,000 have already been identified and a further £800,000 is required over the next 4 years.</p> <p>(ii) As part of the Universal Credit system being introduced by central government, benefit claimants will be required to pay 8.5% of their Council Tax. NDDC is working with the CAB to support claimants in the management of their benefits.</p> <p>(iii) NDDC are passing the grant from central government to help cushion the changes to Parish and Town Councils.</p> <p>(iv) Cost savings include the removal of concessionary fares before 9:30 and exception from Council Tax for second homes and empty houses.</p>
