106/17 – Planning – i) to consider planning applications received: None

107/17 - Fingerposts – update on progress: Letters have been ordered for the post between Droop and Wonston and PB has offered to provide some of her councillor's allowance towards the cost. MW is trying to get a grant application form from the AONB team

108/17 - Footpath and highways matters – update: The Chairman is meeting a resident from Little Whitemoor Farm to see what, if anything, might improve the junction south of Woodrow onto the Causeway. It is a blind junction, and especially difficult when towing a trailer or horsebox. MW has received a complaint about the condition of some bridle-ways – he has suggested the complainant logs these with the Rangers via the Dorsetforyou web site facility. Has the hedge at Kingston Lane/Frizzels Hill been cut – MW will investigate?

109/17 – The Keep: Sadly, the horses have been taken away due to children throwing stones at them. This has reduced the removal of the old grass humps although there was a working party recently working with brush-cutters.

110/17 – Request for a dog waste bin opposite the western end of Coney Lane: A resident had requested a further dog bin as walkers are throwing bags of dog excrement into her garden. Whilst sympathising with the problem there is already a bin no more than 30 metres away. The bins cost just over £100 to purchase and it

would probably be another £10/£15 a month for emptying. The Chairman will suggest that if she buys the bin the parish council will pay for emptying.

111/17 - Recreation Field– a) pavilion update to include progress on building – The minutes of the committee meeting of 24th April had been circulated and were noted. Work is almost complete, including internal fittings. Some tests must be carried out before building control and fire certificates are issued. Align are on the case with Snooks. The build cost should be in line with expectations but the project delays and other test fees will stretch the budget for fees. AR will provide an update on progress in a week's time. MW will summarise final the position on completion. **ii) report and update from Chairman on other matters** – Nothing further to add.

112/17 - Neighbourhood Plan - i) draft minutes of Neighbourhood Plan Committee of 2nd May 2017 to be noted: The minutes were noted **ii) update on progress:** The Call for Sites has flushed out a large supply of “hope” sites, although most were known to us through NDDC’s SHLAA exercise. Evaluation will begin shortly.

113/17 – Village hall – report: Nothing to report

114/17 – DCC/NDDC Cllr Batstone: Safely re-elected, she has resumed her responsibilities for Safeguarding. The 3 district councils continue to work more closely. Norden is to be sold for affordable housing – perhaps 46 units. DM asked if the Section some of the 106 monies from the Handley Cross development would go to the school. PB will re-visit her files.

115/17 - Public open session: The splendid work of local volunteers in finishing internal works at the pavilion was applauded, and now formally noted. It was asked if the next edition of Bytes could encourage parents to educate their children into “poop and scoop” when walking dogs in school holidays. Dog waste on footpaths seems worse in school holiays.
