

Good evening Ladies and Gentlemen.

My name is John Sutton and I am here to speak on behalf of the film group.

We started last December and have had a reasonable successful outcome with attendances averaging 40 over that short space of time.

Some of you will be aware that we have been charging an entrance fee and this combined with the bar income has covered the costs of the hall and licence fee required to allow us to show the movies.

We have now obtained an annual licence for both the films and the bar which will reduce the costs of "Film Night" so in future it is proposed to no longer charge for entrance but to cover the cost with a raffle and the bar proceeds.

Difficulty has been experienced with the projection of films and in order to improve that, an application has been made for funds to provide a new ceiling mounted screen and projection equipment. This equipment would, of course, be available for use by other groups.

Our last film of the season will be "The Railway Man" on Saturday 17th May until we restart in the Autumn.

May I say, on behalf of the film group that we have been encouraged by the interest shown and would always welcome any ideas people may have on future showings because these are for the all the village to enjoy.
